Carol Harkarik, daughter to Tom Skillman, grew up in Montgomery and was one of the many volunteers who worked to save, move and restore Bedensville Schoolhouse for the Bicentennial. In this well-researched book, she provides a full documentation of the early schools in Montgomery.
